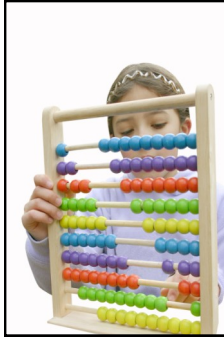


After School Program

For registered youth the cost is only \$45 a week to be escorted by an adult staff person from school to Peck Park Community Recreation Center.

Peck Parks After School Program operates Monday—Friday (unless there is a school holiday or closure) from the time youth are dismissed till 4:30 pm every afternoon. Registration Policies & Procedures

Registration:

Registration: First come, first serve basis, until program is filled. A waiting list will be generated for all persons who register after a program is full. Partial payments are not accepted. Special requests may not be granted or guaranteed. Registration must be received by 5:00 pm the Thursday prior to the first day of a program. Late Payments will be accepted with at \$10 service fee per registrant/program.

Payments:

Payments by check, money order, Visa or MasterCard only. A collection fee will be charged for each check returned by the bank.

No partial payments accepted. Make check payable to: **L.A. City Department of Recreation and Parks.**

Refund Policy:

Refunds will be subjected to a 15% administration fee. No refunds will be approved after a session has begun. No credit or refunds will be approved for missed or partial days. For refund requests due to a medical emergency or related reason; a letter from the treating physician will be required for consideration of refund request.

Youth Escort Policy:

Youth enrolled in Peck Parks Afterschool Program can be, upon parental written approval, escorted from the Peck Park Afterschool Program to a Class or Sports activity. All children must be picked up by the end time of the Afterschool Program, Class or Sports activity. Peck Park Recreation Staff do not stay late to watch children not picked up on time. Late pick ups will be in the Peck Park Office and an additional fee of \$5 per child/per 10 minutes (or fraction thereof) will be assessed.

Parent Code of Conduct:

I understand that I will make only positive and encouraging comments to players on both teams. I will not interfere or 'coach' from the stands. I will strive to create a positive recreational experience for everyone involved in the activity. I understand that the penalties for not adhering to this code of conduct may range from a verbal warning to expulsion from the activity for me and/or my child.

Player Code of Conduct:

I will demonstrate good sportsmanship, I will play by the rules and never argue or complain about the officials decisions, I will be a role-model of good sportsmanship and character. Will meet my responsibilities to the coach and the team.
